TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE PHARE CROSS-BOARDER COOPERATION BULGARIA-TURKEY PROGRAM

Project Objectives

To provide consulting and methodological assistance in carrying out 11 Bulgarian-Turkish cross-boarder projects and monitor their implementation.

Project Implementation Tools

- Developing standards for the project implementation and monitoring;
- Preparing guidelines for the implementation of the funded projects and organizing trainings corresponding to the needs of the project implementation team;
- Providing current consulting for the project implementation team;
- Carrying out PR activities with the view to achieving maximum publicity and transparency of the activities and the results;
- Creating a specialized Internet portal (<http://cbc.osf.bg/>) in order to facilitate the communication between the project implementation team, Implementing Agency – Phare Program at the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works, and the technical assistance for the project;
- Visiting the sites and preparing monitoring reports with recommendations to the implementing team and Implementing Agency – Phare Program at MRDPW;
- Organizing a Bulgarian-Turkish meeting on cross-boarder cooperation to exchange experience and draw morals for the organizations, which have implemented project within the Joint Small Projects Fund, and outline fields for future cooperation.
