

TRAININGS ON THE ABSORPTION OF EU STRUCTURAL FUNDS

Project Objectives

The main aim of the project is to raise the administrative capacity of the non-governmental organizations and representatives of the local authorities, working in the field of Roma issues, and to stimulate the participation of Roma people in competitions for selection of personnel for the EU institutions. The project also aims at providing information on the history, structure and functions of the EU institutions,, the opportunities for applying for, absorption and management of the Structural Funds.

Project Implementation Tools

Within the framework of the project a series of trainings will be organized:

- Training for administrative employees (experts in ethnic and demographic issues, experts in European Integration, etc.) and local Roma NGO on the skills for applying for funding from the Structural Funds and the European Social Fund;
- Training for NGO representatives on the particularities of applying for funding from the Structural Funds;
- Methodological preparation for participation in open competitions for working with the institutions of the European Union.

The suggested project will stimulate the participation of Roma community representatives in the process of developing and managing projects under the European Structural Funds for solving problems, related to the Roma population in the country.
