DEVELOPMENT OF EFFICIENT PARLIAMENTARY DIALOGUE WITH NGO ON THE ISSUES OF DISADVANTAGED PEOPLE

Project Objectives

The main aim of the project is designing and developing an efficient model of parliamentary dialogue with the participation of non-governmental organizations on the issues of disadvantaged people.

The project also aims at establishing a Parliamentary Club to the National Assembly, where the draft laws, related to the vulnerable groups of the society, shall be discussed.

Project Implementation Tools

- Studying the practices of other parliaments of European countries;
- Visit of a Member of European Parliament, working on the problems of vulnerable groups;
- Visit of a group of Members of Bulgarian Parliament, NGO representatives and target group representatives at the European Parliament.
- Working meetings of NGO representatives and Members of Parliament, working on the issues of disadvantaged groups.

Project Status

Under design.

Results

- Establishment of a Parliamentary Club to the National Assembly on the problems of the disadvantaged groups, which will ensure the making of consolidated policy in respect of these issues;
- Exchange of experience between Bulgarian Members of Parliament and their European colleagues in the field of lobbying for social groups' issues and accumulation of useful know-how by Bulgarian members of Parliament;
- Initiation of fruitful partnership between representatives of the parliamentary groups and the non-governmental sector, engaged in the issues of vulnerable groups.
