Project Objectives

Drawing up an entire plan for using the ethnic diversity resources in problem fields. Designing a Diversity Management model. Providing for an environment for common actions on a local community problem, important for the minority representatives, as well as for the majority.

Project Implementation Tools

- Analysis: using qualitative and quantitative research technologies (focus-groups and sociological surveys, desk-research, etc.);
- Planning: designing a model and rendering consulting assistance in solving minority problems on local level;
- Training: conducting a training course on the use of analytical information for planning and programming purposes on municipal level, focusing on minority population problems.

Project Development

In 2005, the project was implemented in the Region of Montana.

Up to present, the experts, engaged in the project, have collected information in the fields of education, health care, social support, as well as information of issues, related to power distribution and water supply of Roma quarters and neighbourhoods in the Region of Montana. The data have been analyzed, mapped and delivered for management to the relevant working groups at the Regional Councils for Cooperation on Ethnic and Demographic Issues in Montana.
