STATE OF ROMA PEOPLE IN BULGARIA III: THE PRICE OF INTEGRATION AS AGAINST THE PRICE OF NON-INTEGRATION

Project Objectives

- Analysis of public funds, spent for the needs of Roma community;
- Comparison between the spent public funds and the set goals in the strategic documents (analysis of the correspondence of the public funds, being spent for improvement of Roma people's state, and the planned tasks in the strategic documents);
- Assessment of the expenses, incurred up to present, in view of achieving Roma policy goals, their adequacy, efficiency, etc.;
- Forecast of the price of this policy, i.e. what is the real price that we shall pay to ensure its efficiency;
- Risk analysis – what will happen if we do not spend the required funds for Roma people integration.

Project Implementation Tools

The project is implemented by two independent research teams, whose conclusions and recommendations will be subjected to comparative analyses.
